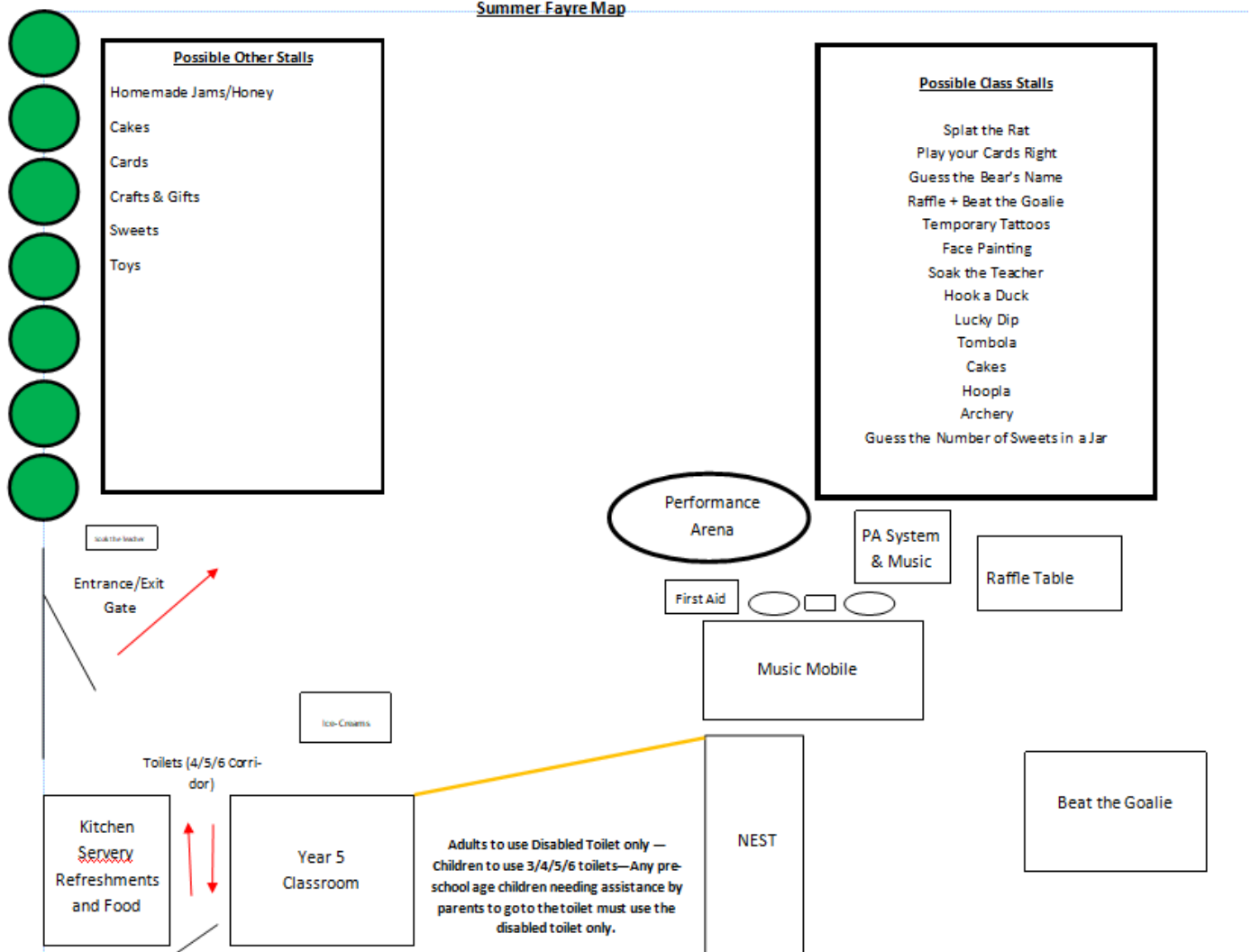
We have lots for you to enjoy laid on by the staff and PTFA.


Please also remember we have our adult and child Bake-Off competitions for any amateur or budding chefs out there.
