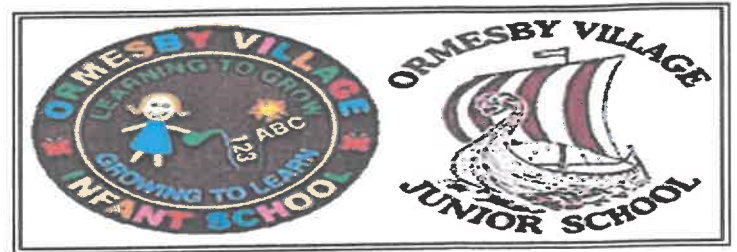

Dear Families,

As our trip to Whitwell Hall approaches I wanted to get a kit list out to you so that you can gather together any items you don't already have at home.

Clothing:

- 3 warm jumpers- hoodies/sweatshirts which will fit under a coat or a fleece that can be layered
- 5 pairs of comfortable, light weight bottoms- leggings or joggers will be fine.
- 3 pairs of shorts.
- 8 sets of underwear- the children will be getting wet on at least one occasion so plenty of changes are a must.
- 8 tops- a mixture of long and short sleeved.
- Waterproof trousers
- A waterproof coat
- A set of pyjamas
- A dressing gown
- A sunhat

Bedding:

- A pillow
- A duvet or sleeping bag

Toiletries:

- Shower gel
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Shampoo (and conditioner)
- Sanitary products (girls)
- Factor 50 water resistant sun cream
- Hair brush
- Hairbands for long hair (more than you think they'd need!)
- Lip balm
- Bite and sting cream
- Insect repellent

(a wash bag is really helpful as they will have to walk a little way to the showers. A carrier bag would be absolutely fine if you don't have one)



Other:

- Water bottle
- Calpol (named to be handed in to Mrs Angel on the morning of the trip along with the attached form)
- A book
- Asthma inhalers and any other regular medication (please fill in the form and notify Mrs Angel)
- A binbag to store wet, muddy clothes in
- Two towels
- Torch

Footwear:

- Indoor shoes (sliders or slippers, please don't send flip flops, the sock admin is a bit much!)
- Trainers/ walking boots which you don't mind getting muddy and wet
- Wellies

Please don't send:

- Food- Whitwell hall do not allow food to be taken upstairs. I promise they will not go hungry, there are snacks on offer all the time.
- Electrical items/ phones
- Any items of clothing you don't want to get stained or muddy

I know this seems like a lot of kit, we won't be able to do any washing over the five days and they will be in and out of the mud and the water all the time. Please name as much of their kit as you can, it saves a lot of work.
