We are writing to inform you of an upcoming educational visit for 6SY, which will take place later this term.

The visit will take place on **Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> January 2026** at **East Norfolk Sixth Form College**. The class will depart from school at **10:30am** and return by approximately **1:15pm**. Pupils will travel to and from the venue by coach.

The cost of the visit will be **£8.50 per pupil**, or **£4.50** for those pupils in receipt of Pupil Premium. Payments should be made via Iris ParentMail under the heading ENSFC.

The purpose of the visit is to support pupils' STEM learning, with a particular focus on renewable energy.

As the visit extends over the school lunchbreak, the children will require a packed lunch on this day. If your child qualifies for free school meals, please indicate on the consent form below whether your child will require a ham or cheese packed lunch prepared by the kitchen and return the order slip by **Friday 16<sup>th</sup> January 2026**.

During the visit, pupils will take part in a STEM-focused workshop exploring renewable energy. The session is designed to help children understand different types of renewable energy, how energy is generated sustainably, and why renewable sources are important for the future. Activities will be practical, interactive, and closely linked to our science curriculum.

Children will be supervised by school staff at all times, and appropriate risk assessments will be in place.

School uniform should be worn as normal.
